



**CALL FOR NOMINATIONS: TWO (2) EXPERTS APPOINTED TO THE COUNCIL ON THE BASIS OF THEIR EXPERTISE AND EXPERIENCE IN (I) HUMAN RESOURCES MANAGEMENT AND (II) LAW RESPECTIVELY**

Sefako Makgatho Health Sciences University (SMU) plays an important role in addressing the human capital development needs of South Africa and the rest of the African continent in both health care and science & technology fields. The Council of the SMU is the governing body of the University, and has, as part of its fiduciary duty, a responsibility to determine the strategic direction of the University. **Two (2) vacancies** in the category of experts who are appointed to the Council on the basis of their expertise and experience (i) human resources and (ii) law, have arisen, necessitating the call for nominations. In terms of paragraph 20(6) of the SMU Statute, organizations, interest groups and individuals are invited to nominate qualifying candidates to fill the following two vacancies:

<p>Nominated candidates must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>have worked in the human resources management field for a minimum period of fifteen (15) years, and five (5) of which at executive and senior management level;</li> <li>possess proven and sound knowledge of the human resources management field;</li> <li>be qualified with a Master's degree at NQF level 9 or above, and</li> <li>have more than 5 years Board or Board equivalent or Board Committee experience.</li> </ol>	<p>Nominated candidates must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>have worked in the legal field for a minimum period of fifteen (15) years, and five (5) of which as a Senior Counsel (SC);</li> <li>be admitted attorneys/advocates of the High Court in South Africa;</li> <li>be a member of the Legal Practice Council;</li> <li>be qualified with a minimum of a Bachelor's degree at NQF level 8 or equivalent, and</li> <li>have more than 5 years Board or Board equivalent or Board Committee experience, which will be an added advantage.</li> </ol>

Each nomination should be accompanied by a comprehensive Curriculum Vitae of the nominee and must be signed by the nominator. In addition, the nominee must indicate his/her acceptance of the nomination in writing. Nomination forms are available from the Office of the Registrar and/or on the SMU website. Nominations must reach the Registrar's Office no later than **16:00 on Monday, 17 April 2023**.
