Who Should Apply?

SMU students and community members with experience or a strong interest in radio. We are looking for individuals with:

- A clear, engaging speaking voice (Presenters & News Readers)
- Ability to operate radio equipment during a live show (Presenters & News Readers – will be tested)
- Strong communication and on-air presentation skills
- Technical aptitude for audio production and studio operations (Technical Crew – will be tested)
- Excellent knowledge of music genres, sequencing, and playlist curation (Music Compiler)
- Reliability, professionalism, and availability aligned with the station's programming schedule

What to Submit

All Applicants:

- A CV (maximum 2 pages)

Presenters & News Readers:

- A 2-minute audio or video demo showcasing your presenting or news-reading ability.

Technical Crew:

Submit the following as evidence of technical capability:

- **A 2-minute video** demonstrating how you set up or operate radio/audio equipment
- **A 1–2 minute audio mix** (preferably jingles) you produced
- **A portfolio** (PDF or screenshots) showing previous technical work, such as:
 - o Studio setup
 - o Audio editing
 - o Produced shows/podcasts
 - o Equipment configuration

(Shortlisted candidates will undergo a practical technical assessment.)

Music Compiler:

Submit the following:

- A sample curated playlist (15–20 songs) with a brief note on theme, sequencing, and target audience
- A short audio mix demonstrating genre range and flow
- A 1-page motivation explaining your understanding of music programming, audience fit, and radio playlist building
