NOTICE OF CONVOCAATION GENERAL MEETING, SATURDAY, 16 MAY 2026 AT FOREVER RESORTS BADPLAAS, MPUMALANGA PROVINCE FROM 09:00 TO 13:00

1. BACKGROUND

Following the call for nominations and the close of the nomination process, the University conducted a verification and vetting process in accordance with the applicable prescripts. In doing so, the University had amongst others regard to **Chapter 8 of the Institutional Statute** and the **Constitution of the Convocation**, together with the requirements set out in the published notice (including completion of the prescribed nomination form and submission of the required supporting documentation).

On completion of this initial vetting phase, the University published a **provisional list** of nominees on the prescribed platforms, namely **national newspapers** and the **SMU website**, in order to formally notify Convocation members of the nominations received and to provide an opportunity for enquiries and objections to be lodged in terms of the published process.

2. ENQUIRIES AND OBJECTIONS RECEIVED AND OUTCOME

In line with the published notice, Convocation members were afforded an opportunity to submit enquiries and/or objections regarding any name **included** or **omitted** from the published provisional list, within the stipulated period. The submissions received were reviewed and processed, and the provisional list has been corrected where warranted (including the removal of ineligible nominees and the correction of administrative capturing errors).

Accordingly, the **final list of verified nominees** is confirmed as follows:

2.1. Removal

- **Dr Biyela Shareen Talente** is **removed** from the nominees' list on the basis that the nominee is currently registered for a qualification at SMU, and is therefore not eligible for the relevant Convocation Executive portfolio(s) in terms of the applicable prescripts (including the Institutional Statute provisions dealing with eligibility for Convocation office-bearers).

2.2. Administrative correction / inclusion

- **Mr Munyai Eugene** is **included** as a nominee for the position of **Vice-President**.
- **Mr Radebe Vusimusi Collet** is **included** as a nominee for the positions of **Vice-President** and **Additional Members**.

4. ELIGIBILITY TO VOTE AND MEETING REQUIREMENTS

4.1. Membership and voting entitlement

In terms of Chapter 8 of the Institutional Statute:

“The official roll of the Convocation is conclusive evidence of membership of the Convocation and only a person whose name appears on the roll at the time of his or her claiming the right to vote as a member of the Convocation is entitled to do so.”

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Accordingly, only members whose details appear on the **official Convocation roll** at the time of registration will be entitled to vote.

4.2. Identification requirement

All attendees must present a valid **South African ID document/card** or **driver's licence** for admission and verification at registration.

4.3. QUORUM

In terms of Chapter 8 of the Institutional Statute:

“Subject to the provisions of this Statute, 100 members form a quorum, but if a meeting is adjourned owing to failure to reach a quorum, a special meeting must be convened within eight weeks and the members present at such a meeting will be deemed to form a quorum.”

Members are therefore urged to attend to ensure that the General Meeting is duly constituted.
