HOW TO APPLY FOR ADMISSION TO POST-GRADUATE STUDIES



All Post Graduate applicants may apply online except for those listed under **B**.

A. Upload the following documents **certified copies** of the following documents:

- * Matric exemption certificate (including subject marks)
- * ID document / Passport / Work permit / Study permit
- * Diploma/Degree certificate/s
- * Comprehensive academic record (indicating marks obtained for subjects)
- * Certificate of registration with the relevant professional council (if applicable)
- * Letter of appointment as registrar **with a date of assumption of duty**:
NB: letter from the employer - applicable for **MMed and MDent students**,
- * Medical aid (**Non-South Africans**)
- * Students with non-South African qualifications must attach SAQA evaluation certificate with their previous degrees obtained.
- * Application fee
- * Motivational letter and CV-applicable for **Public Health** applications
- * 2 Motivational letters - applicable for **MPharm** applicants

B. APPLICATION IN PERSON

NB. Applicable to: For only MMED, MSC by research and PHD who are registering for the **first time for the current year**.

C. INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

The South African Constitution and the Act on Higher Learning allows students from other countries, especially in the SADC Region to be feeder areas to South African Universities.

- C.1 A formal request for admission must be submitted to the International Office, P O Box 189, MEDUNSA, 0204
- C.2 Applications for admission must be made and assessment and evaluation of certificates completed the year before commencement of studies
- C.3 Full details regarding the requirements for obtaining a study permit may be obtained from the South African Embassy or South African High Commissioner in your country

C.4 SAQA evaluation of academic qualifications must accompany the application for admission.
