- are Honours BSc students, Pharmacy 3rd year students, Oral Health Sciences 3rd year (BOH, BDT) and 4th year (BDS) students, Health Care Sciences 3rd year students, MBChB 4th year students and BRad 3rd year students

- Presentations skills
- Knowledge of the principles of confidentiality and informed consent
